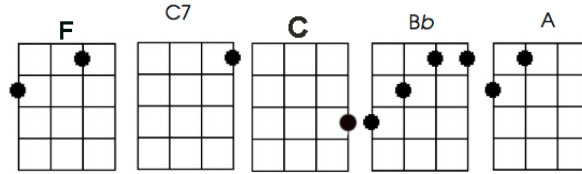


# Everybody Loves A Lover
